Floral Bunny and Carrot Crate Instructions



In your Kit:

- Wood Bunny
- Floral Pieces, Nose, Eye, Ears, & Tail
- Happy Easter & 5 cents Words
- 2 Wood Blocks and 7 Slats
- 2 Stand pieces (slotted half round & triangle)
- 6 Paint Pots
- Glue
- 1 small detail brush
- Black Sponge brush
- Round Sponge Dabber
- 2 Makeup Sponges
- Paint Tray
- Sandpaper Block

What you will need:

- Water cup for rinsing your brush
- Table Cloth
- Rag/Paper towels
- Ruler

Instructions:

- Layout all your pieces first to ensure you are painting the correct side.
- Paint all bunny pieces according to the picture, using the black sponge for larger pieces and make up sponges for smaller pieces. After the bunny is dry add white polk a dots using the round sponge dabber to the bunny.
- Let it all dry. Then glue the pieces on the bunny board.
- Glue the half round to the back middle of the bunny, the triangle slots into it and props up the bunny. You can also glue the half round to the top to use for a nail slot and hang on the wall.
- Paint only one side of all crate pieces: wood blocks and slats. Paint the 5¢.
- Glue 3 slats to the 3 1/2' longer side (bottom) of the wood blocks, equal spaced. Glue 2 slats to each side of wood blocks (2 1/2" short sides); one on top and one along the bottom edge.
- Cut Napkin in half, then cut narrow slits on the folded side to create grass for the crate.

Tips:

- These are just guidelines, feel free to paint/decorate however you choose.
- For smaller pieces, place a strip of tape sticky side up on your table, place the smaller piece on it, this will hold them down while you paint.
- Some areas may require 2-3 coats, let dry completely before applying additional coats. After painting, some pieces may have little fibers that swell and cause a rough texture, use a fine grit sand paper and very lightly sand the fibers off.
