



# You are Loved

## Your kit contains:

- Round Base, You are Loved, Hello, & 3 Hearts
  - 3 Paint Pots, Black Sponge Brush, a Makeup Sponge, & Paint Tray
  - 2 Super Glue & Sanding Block
  - 6 Pieces of Felt
  - String & raffia
- A Little Extra...
- Wood block, Words of Love, & 2-pattern paper, mod podge

## What you need:

- Scissors
- Pencil
- Masking Tape
- Water rinse cup
- Glue Gun
- Table Cloth
- Rag/Paper towels

## Instructions:

- Layout all your pieces first to ensure you are painting the correct side.
- Paint the base tan, slightly watered down, wipe any excess off. Let dry. Then apply a white slightly watered-down coat, wipe away any excess.
- Paint the frame and words black. Let dry then glue to the base.
- Large and small rose: Trace the pattern and cut out the circles. Cut a spiral into the circle. Start rolling the spiral from the outer circle edge. The bottom/inside of the spiral pieces is the bottom of the flower, keep that end flat as you roll. Once you get to the last bit of the spiral use it to glue the bottom. Different-sized circles will make different-sized flowers, have fun trying it out.
- Pom Pom: Trace the pattern and cut the rectangle. Glue along the long edge, cut strips along the folded edge. Roll so the glued edge stays flat, when you get to the end, add a dap of glue to hold. Fluff as needed. Different-sized rectangles will make different-sized flowers, have fun trying it out.
- Cosmo: Trace the pattern so the dotted line is on a fold. Cut 4 shapes, they should look like a heart. Cut the centerpiece ( the long skinny rectangle), fold in half, glue along the long edge, cut tiny snips in the folded edge. Roll the strip, keeping the glued edge flat, that is the bottom. Finish with a dap of glue at the end. Layer your heart pieces so the points all overlap in the center, glue. Then glue the rolled center part in the center of the flower.
- Leaves: Trace and cut, make different sizes you any color you like.
- After your flowers are made arrange them, the leaves, the hearts, the raffia, and string on the base. Once you have an arrangement you like start gluing them on

## Tips:

- These are just guidelines, feel free to paint/decorate however you choose.
- For smaller pieces, place a strip of tape sticky side up on your table, place the smaller piece on it, this will hold them down while you paint.
- Some areas may require 2-3 coats, let dry completely before applying additional coats. After painting, some pieces may have tiny fibers that swell and cause a rough texture, use a fine grit sand paper and very lightly sand smooth.
