

# Interchangeable Season Sign



## Your kit contains:

- 8" Square Base, Frame, 4 Seasons
- 3 Paint Pots, Black Sponge Brush, Makeup Sponge, & Paint Tray
- Super Glue & Sanding Block
- Easel Stand

## What you need:

- Masking Tape
- Ruler (optional)
- Baby Wipes or Damp Rag/Paper Towel
- Water rinse cup
- Table Cloth
- Rag/Paper towels

## Instructions:

- Layout all your pieces first to ensure you are painting the correct side.
- Using a damp rag or baby wipe rub dark wax on 2 lattice pieces.
- Using the makeup sponge paint the circle frame, the 4 long frame pieces, and the 4 season word cutouts black.
- Using the black sponge brush paint the 4 solid circles white. Slightly water down the paint to help it spread. White will require 2 coats.
- Once everything is completely dry glue the lattice square bases together. The lattice square with the large open circle is the top piece, rotate the piece to get the lattice strips to be opposite of each. Glue the circle frame on the lattice base ensure the inner circles align. Glue the 4 long frame pieces on the lattice base ensure the outside is aligned. Glue the season word cutouts on the circle solid bases.

## Tips:

- These are just guidelines, feel free to paint/decorate however you choose.
- For smaller pieces, place a strip of tape sticky side up on your table, place the smaller piece on it, this will hold them down while you paint.
- Some areas may require 2-3 coats, let dry completely before applying additional coats. After painting, some pieces may have tiny fibers that swell and cause a rough texture, use a fine grit sand paper and very lightly sand smooth.
